CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Be a Brother Hero: Help Us Reach Our Goal

Chapter House Improvements Begin Thanks to Capital Donations

We are in the midst of a capital campaign to raise significant funds to ensure the Pennsylvania Theta Chapter House continues to be operational and safe for both today's brothers and for generations to come. The chapter is thriving on campus (come visit!) but the physical house is not. Now is the time for each of us to step up and do our part – BE A BROTHER HERO AND CONTRIBUTE!

This campaign is distinct from our annual fund that is used to keep track of our alumni, maintain the Penn Theta website, produce the monthly eLetters, and issue the semi-annual newsletters. Capital campaign donations will be considered gifts to Penn and will be processed by Penn's Development Office. This ensures that funds will be allocated and used properly, since Penn must approve the release of funds for capital renovations. Donations made to the campaign are eligible for tax deductions, and you will receive a gift receipt from Penn.

More than 97 (and that number is growing!) of your brothers have already pledged or contributed over \$300,000. Thank you to those Brother Heroes! The capital funds raised will be used for necessary repairs, deferred maintenance, and code enforcement updates to the Chapter House to ensure that it remains viable for at least another 25 years (the last time significant work was performed was about 25 years ago). Thanks to the over \$200,000 already collected, work began this summer.

This is not a project to make the Chapter House a luxury dorm, but to address serious, necessary (but not sexy) issues such as:

- Repair to the Butler Pantry (which was about to collapse) Project Complete!
- Repair of the foyer floor (which almost collapsed)
- Fixing the brick façade and landscaping
- Repair the fire escape to bring it up to code

- A major overhaul of the electrical system (also to bring it up to code)
- Refurbishment of the heating systems
- Minor items (carpet, plumbing)

The identified list of needed projects is in excess of \$250,000. But the more we raise, the more we can do!

While ALL donations will be acknowledged at the conclusion of the campaign, special donor recognition levels have been set at the following milestones: \$75,000, \$50,000,

\$25,000, \$10,000, \$5,000, \$2,500 \$1,000 and participation. In addition, the class with the highest percentage participation will receive special recognition.

We will accept multi-year pledges (up to a maximum of five years), but

Thank you to Harold Denmark Sr. '52 for sharing the following...

"I learned to be loyal, sharing and to be a gentleman while attending the U. of P. Today I share my knowledge with young students in all parts of the world in my fields of entomology and acarology. I have published extensively in both disciplines. My last book (451pages) was on the predaceous mites (Phytoseeidae) in North America. I have shared this book with students worldwide, and am now working on my last publication as I am now 92.

My experience at SAE was much different than it would be today. I joined during WWII and I had been away from home for two years. It was a home away from home. I enjoyed the fellowship. I developed the right attitude of a gentleman. Today I try to keep this attitude and am loyal to my friends and family."


We're Seeking Email Addresses for More than Half of Alumni, Especially Our '70s Brothers!
